Assessment Plan:

Utah State University Eastern Certified Nursing Assistant Program uses the following criteria as outcome measures of the effectiveness of the program:

- Utah State University Eastern Blanding, Moab and Price campus Certified Nursing Assistant Program adheres to the guidelines set forth by Utah Nurses Aid Registry which not only guides curriculum criteria, but also guides the program in outcome based standards.
- Each of USU Eastern CNA programs must maintain a 75% pass rate
- Students must pass all written exams with a 75% or higher
- Students must maintain a GPA of 2.75 for admittance and throughout the program
- Students must prove competency in all skills areas through skills pass off labs
- A final exam must be passed with a 75% or higher
- A hands-on skills exam must be passed with an 80% or higher
- Increase the number of students taking the state certification exam to at least 50% of the currently enrolled students per semester.
