

DATA-BASED DECISIONS AAS-Nursing Curriculum

- 1. Nursing faculty agreed to migrate curriculum to a concept-based methodology. Fall semester courses have been adopted to deliver by Fall 2016 with Spring semester courses adopted to deliver by Spring 2017.**
- 2. Nursing faculty agreed to reduce the number and prevalence of courses taught by 2 or more instructors. It was agreed that providing one instructor should improve continuity and consistency of course content delivery.**
- 3. NURS 2120 will be removed from the curriculum and replaced with a new course NURS 2140. This course will address several deficiencies identified during the assessment discussions of the Nursing faculty.**
- 4. NURS 2240 course was added to serve as a Capstone experience for the AAS-Nursing curriculum in an attempt to incorporate the many themes of the SLO's in a summative experience.**
- 5. Due to driving time and distances among clinical sites in selected program locations the Director of Nursing will work on establishing cooperative opportunities at appropriate sites closer to USU campuses.**
