

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

OUTCOMES DATA:

100% of medical assisting students have graduated from the Blanding program, 50% have graduated from the Price program.

100% of medical assisting students have found positive placement in employment as a medical assistant or in a related field from the Blanding program, while the Price program has had (TBD) placement.

95% of the graduates from the Blanding program have sat for the National Certifying exam through AMT with one student remaining that is scheduled to sit for the exam in November 2016. No students from the Price program have taken the certifying exam for the following reasons:

100% of all graduate survey responders either “strongly agree” or “agree” that the overall program quality prepared them adequately as a medical assistant.

100% of all employers returning the survey “strongly agree” or “agree” that overall our graduates are well-prepared employees.
