

Utah State University Nursing Program Clinical Immunization and Testing Requirements

- Urine Drug Screen (SAM 5)
- Background Check
- American Heart Association BLS for Healthcare Providers
- Two-step tuberculin skin test (two separate Tuberculin Skin Tests, aka PPD tests) or a one-time blood test (QuantiFERON Gold or T-SPOT).
If positive test result, documentation of normal CXR provided by physician or health department.
- Date of vaccination or nasal spray: ____/____/____ Annual / current flu immunization: (each Fall, due by November 1)
- Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR). Two vaccinations given at recommended intervals or laboratory evidence.
- T-dap immunization.
- Varicella (Chicken Pox). Two vaccinations given at recommended intervals or laboratory evidence.
- Hepatitis B series (three vaccinations) and reactive titer or laboratory evidence. A Hep. B series should be offered if the student assignment may involve exposure, or potential exposure, to blood, body fluid or tissue specimens.
